Jelena Vapa Tankosić is a full professor of economics at the Faculty of Economics and Engineering Management, University of Business Academy in Novi Sad. She is a Vice Dean for cooperation with business entities, Head of the Office for cooperation with business entities, education and professional development of business entities, and management of students' professional practice, as well as a Deputy Head of the Faculty Project Office. She has participated in many international projects related to European integration. She has participated in many national projects of the Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Water Management – Agricultural Payments Administration; Provincial Secretariat for Science and Technological Development, Provincial Secretariat for Higher Education and Scientific Research, and Environmental Protection Administration of Novi Sad. She is the author and co-author of more than 150 scientific research papers published in international scientific journals, national scientific journals, proceedings of international and national scientific conferences, and international and national monographs. She is a reviewer for several international and national journals.
